The finals of the eighth CUHK Entrepreneurship Competition tomorrow will see five finalists presenting their research and development ideas. A total of HK\$100,000 will be awarded to the winner and the first and second runners-up. This year's competition invited a number of CUHK alumni and industry experts to serve as star judges and provide advice to the start-up teams, including alumnus Joseph Cheung, Director of CUHK Alumni Entrepreneurship Foundation; alumnus Alan Lam, Chief Executive Officer of Gravity Capital Partners Company Limited; alumnus Raymond Chu, Associate Director of University Collaborations, HKSTP; alumnus Ricky Choi, Lead of the Smart Living Cluster of Cyberport; and Mr Eric Woo, Investment Analyst for Alibaba Entrepreneurs Fund.
