About the Jockey Club MEL Institute Project (Phase Two)

Funded by The Hong Kong Jockey Club Charities Trust, CUHK's Department of Social Work has run a three-year programme, the Jockey Club MEL Institute Project (Phase Two), since 2022 to extend experience and knowledge of Monitoring, Evaluation and Learning (MEL) among local NGOs and social enterprises. The Project provides a 14-session training course delivered by overseas and local experts, which covers four main areas: Service Development and Monitoring, Infrastructure and Talent Development for MEL Organisational Practice, Outcome and Impact Communication, and Programme Evaluation and Impact Assessment. Participants also take part in a four-month mentored practicum to gain practical knowledge in programme evaluation by applying it to their work under the coaching of experienced mentors. Besides the training course and mentored practicum, the Project also includes an Online Knowledge Hub, which serves as a primary channel to enhance participants' learning experiences.
